RULES OF THE CEMETERIES

In compiling these codes and ordinances, the City has endeavored to safeguard the individual lot owners as well as the cemeteries as a whole.

Auburndale cemeteries have what is generally known as “perpetual care.” The City will maintain the cemeteries in keeping a well-preserved burial plot including:

- 1) The cutting of grass and trimming of shrubs and trees at reasonable intervals.
- 2) Keeping in good repair the drains, water lines, roads, buildings and other structures.
- 3.) Maintaining the necessary records of lot ownership and burials and other necessary information and making it available to the public authorities and interested persons.

PURPOSE:

The cemeteries are set apart for the exclusive burial of human remains and shall be used for cemetery purposes only.

ADMINISTRATION:

The administration of rules is placed by the City Manager and he is authorized to enforce them.

The City shall have the right to correct any errors that may be made in good faith, either in making interments, disinterments, or removals, or in the descriptions, transfer, or conveyance of any interment property.

The City shall not be liable and distinctly disclaims all responsibility for loss or damage to property or rights of lot owners arising from causes beyond its reasonable control, and especially, from elements, acts of God, thieves, vandals, unavoidable accidents, whether the damage be direct or collateral.

The cemetery employees are prohibited from taking payments or tips from lot owners for special work during regular working hours. They are glad to assist you in any way they can each plot owner shall keep the City informed as to their correct mailing address.

CONDUCT OF PEOPLE VISITING THE CEMETERIES:

Visitors are reminded that these grounds are devoted to the interment of the dead and that a strict observance of the decorum which should characterize the place will be required. Cemetery hours are 7:00 am to Sunset daily.

Persons within the cemetery grounds shall use only the walks and roads provided.

Automobiles must not be driven over fifteen (15) miles per hour or driven anywhere but on the roadways provided in the cemetery.

PROHIBITIONS:

No person shall gather flowers, damage trees, shrubbery of plants or feed or disturb the birds or other animal life.

No person shall have refreshments within the cemetery.

No soliciting shall be permitted in the cemetery.

No dogs are permitted in the cemetery.

No signs or notices of any kind shall be placed in the cemetery other than by the City of Auburndale.

LOT SALES AND TRANSFERS:

The sale prices of all lots or grave spaces shall be set by the City Commission and are on file in the City Clerk's Office.

Resale of cemetery lots may be made only to the City. The City will refund the purchase price of the lots upon your written notarized request.

No title to a lot shall be deemed valid until the amount of the purchase money has been paid.

LOT MAINTENANCE AND LANDSCAPING:

All plants must be in a pot. Planting is prohibited.

Funeral designs and floral pieces will be removed from graves when they become wilted or unsightly. Persons desiring to retain any must remove or pick up same at the cemetery.

The City shall not be responsible for floral pieces, baskets, frames, flags, receptacles or personal memorabilia.

All items of glass, brick, cement, wood or metal except for the temporary metal markers for a short period of time or any toys, souvenirs, or emblems are prohibited from being placed on any lot.

No planting or removal of flowers or shrubs of any kind is permitted on plots in the cemetery. All plants in violation of this rule will be immediately removed at the City's discretion.

CURBS AND FENCES AROUND LOTS:

No curbing, hedging, corner posts, grave mounds, borders, fence pipe, chains, or enclosures of any kind will be allowed. Coping will be allowed in designated areas, meeting criteria established by the cemetery division.

MONUMENTS:

Monument builders shall set monuments and markers in conformity with cemetery requirements and in accordance with the trade standards of proper methods of handling a setting. Reference City Code Chapter 8 regarding rules for monuments.

SYMBOLS:

Symbols, as of faith, hope and love, as well as religious symbols and emblems of fraternal and military organizations contribute to the significance of the memorial. It is therefore, recommended that symbols, epitaphs and historical inscriptions be used whenever possible on the memorial monument.
