Industrial Accident Kills Man In Auburndale

Auburndale police responded to the city of Auburndale’s waste water treatment plant at 890 Braddock Road at about 8:30am this morning to investigate an industrial accident. Sub-contracted workers from Indian River Industrial Contractors, Inc. out of Jacksonville were working at the treatment plant.

Mark Ingram, 12-21-1966 of 3924 Roberts Avenue in Auburndale was attempting to hook cabling to a track hoe bucket to lift a large concrete sewer box. The track hoe operator put the machine in neutral, which is suppose to lock all movement of the machine, leaving the machine to assist Mr. Ingram. The track hoe moved forward causing the large track hoe bucket to strike Mr. Ingram killing him. Mr. Ingram was pronounced dead at the scene by medical personnel. The investigation by law enforcement does not indicate any foul play.

OSHA responded to the scene and are conducting an investigation into the accident.
