Police Catch Car Thieves

The owner of “It’s a Piece of Cake” in downtown Auburndale, Margaret “Maggie” Guzman had her 2003 silver Chrysler Mini-van stolen from in front of her shop Sunday morning. Maggie parked her van in front of her business located at 220 E. Park Street in Auburndale. She was inside finishing some work and came out at about 11:30am and started the van to cool the interior. Maggie had to make a cake delivery and the cakes needed to be kept cool. When she went back into the store to get the cake, three men took advantage of the un-locked running vehicle.

Witnesses were able to describe the suspects to police along with a description of the van. Police immediately began searching the area for the stolen van and suspects. The van was spotted by police on north SR 559 near Sutton Place, officers were able to stop the van and arrest the suspects without incident.

Arrested were the driver, Luther Randy Troller 24 yoa of 105 Dickey St in Auburndale. His brother, Timothy James Troller 25 yoa of 105 Dickey St in Auburndale, and David Andrew Frushour 22 yoa of 744 Hillcrest Dr in Davenport. Each were charged with burglary to a vehicle and grand theft auto.
