Bank Robbery

Police were dispatched to the Bank of America 300 Havendale Blvd. in Auburndale at 12:41 pm in reference to a Robbery. The suspect is about 6'00 tall 200-210 pounds, and is described as a light skinned black male wearing tan pants, long sleeve shirt and tan shoes. The suspect was wearing a wig of some sort, sun glasses and has a mustache and goatee. The suspect presented a note to the teller, (unknown what the note said, the suspect took the note with him). The teller put an undermined amount of money into a white envelope the suspect handed to the teller. The suspect left the bank on foot heading southwest towards Derby Avenue. There were no injuries reported in the robbery. Police are continuing their search for the suspect with the assistance of the Polk County Sheriff's Office.
