### Stabbing

The Auburndale Police were called to Brew Hounds Sports Bar, 318 Havendale Blvd. on 1/16/2013 at about 11:35pm for a fight in the parking lot. The three victims were found in the parking lot each suffering from cuts or stabs from the suspect's knife.

Initial reports indicated the altercation stemmed from an argument between Mr. Dunlap and Mr. Garcia about racing their vehicles. The argument became physical when Mr. Rivera was said to have pushed Mr. Garcia. A fight broke out with several people involved. During the fight, Mr. Garcia pulled out a pocket knife and began aggressively swing it at the victims. Mr. Garcia cut Mr. Rivera in several places to include his nose, just below his left eye, right hand and his bicep. Mr. Hageman was cut in the back of the head with an approximate 4 inch long cut. Mr. Dunlap was stabbed just below the rib cage on his left side. Mr. Garcia left Brew Hounds in a white vehicle.

Through the investigation, police were able to identify Mr. Garcia as the suspect by a partial tag number and description of the vehicle that was given to them by Mr. Hageman. A photo pack was shown to the victims and they were able to identify Mr. Garcia as the suspect, he was arrested on Friday, 1/18/2013 at about 10:00am at his residence without incident.

All three victims were transported to Lakeland Regional Medical Center for their injuries. Mr. Dunlap required surgery for his stab wound. All three are expected to recovery from their injuries.
