Notice is hereby given that the City Commission of the City of Auburndale, Florida, will hold a **Public Hearing** on Monday, March 4, 2019, at 7:00 p.m., in the City Commission Room, City Hall, to hear and consider the first reading of a proposed Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 764, the City's Land Development Regulations and Official Zoning Map.

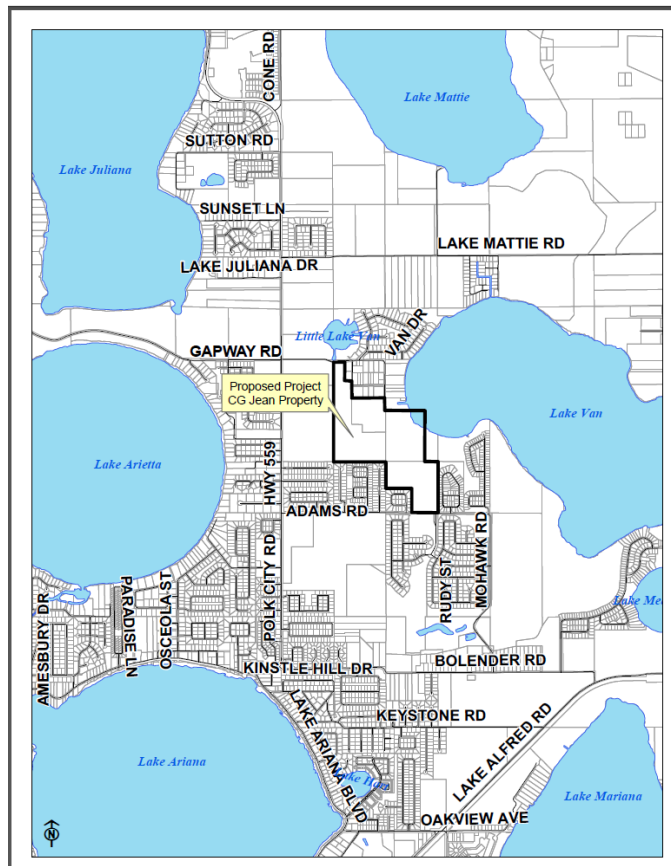
The proposed Land Development Regulations and Official Zoning Map Ordinance is entitled: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AUBURNDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 764, THE LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF AUBURNDALE, FLORIDA, BY ESTABLISHING A ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF PLANNED DEVELOPMENT-HOUSING 1 (PD-H1) ON PARCELS OF LAND TOTALING +/- 120.56 ACRES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE (General Location: Adams Road and Lake Van Road).

**Amend the Zoning Map as follows:**

**CG Jeans Road Property:** Amend the City of Auburndale Zoning Map by establishing zoning of PD-H1 on the following property:

The proposed Ordinance is available for review in the Planner's Office, City Hall, One Bobby Green Plaza, Florida, weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Interested parties may examine the Ordinance and Map there or appear at the meeting and be heard with respect to such proposed amendments.
