**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AUBURNDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 764, THE LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF AUBURNDALE, FLORIDA, BY A RE-ESTABLISHING AN EXPIRED CITY OF AUBURNDALE ZONING MAP CLASSIFICATION OF PLANNED DEVELOPMENT-HOUSING 1 (PD-H1) ON A PARCEL OF LAND TOTALING +/- 65.38 ACRES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE** (General Location: Keystone Road and Old Lake Alfred Road).

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AUBURNDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 764, THE LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF AUBURNDALE, FLORIDA, BY AN AMENDMENT TO THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP BY ESTABLISHING A CITY OF AUBURNDALE ZONING MAP CLASSIFICATION OF PLANNED DEVELOPMENT-HOUSING 1 (PD-H1) ON A PARCEL OF LAND TOTALING +/- 57.75 ACRES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE** (General Location: Old Berkley Road and Gapway Road).

**ORDINANCE NO. 1615**

**AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AUBURNDALE, FLORIDA, SO AS TO INCLUDE THEREIN ADDITIONAL TERRITORY LYING CONTIGUOUS AND ADJACENT TO THE PRESENT BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY; DESCRIBING SAID ADDITIONAL TERRITORY; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE** (General Location: Berkley Road and Pearce Road).
