AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AUBURNDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 752, THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE CITY OF AUBURNDALE, FLORIDA, BY AMENDING THE FUTURE LAND USE MAP RECLASSIFYING A PARCEL OF LAND TOTALING +/- 0.15 ACRES FROM POLK COUNTY FUTURE LAND USE CLASSIFICATION RESIDENTIAL SUBURBAN (RS) TO CITY OF AUBURNDALE FUTURE LAND USE CLASSIFICATION LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE (General Location: T. E. Williams Road).

E. Williams Road).

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AUBURNDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 764, THE LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF AUBURNDALE, FLORIDA, BY AN AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING MAP RECLASSIFYING AN AUBURNDALE ZONING MAP CLASSIFICATION ON PARCELS OF LAND TOTALING +/- 104 ACRES FROM CITY OF AUBURNDALE ZONING CLASSIFICATION SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (RS-1) TO SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL-2 (RS-2); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE (General Location: Hwy. 559 and Adams Road).
