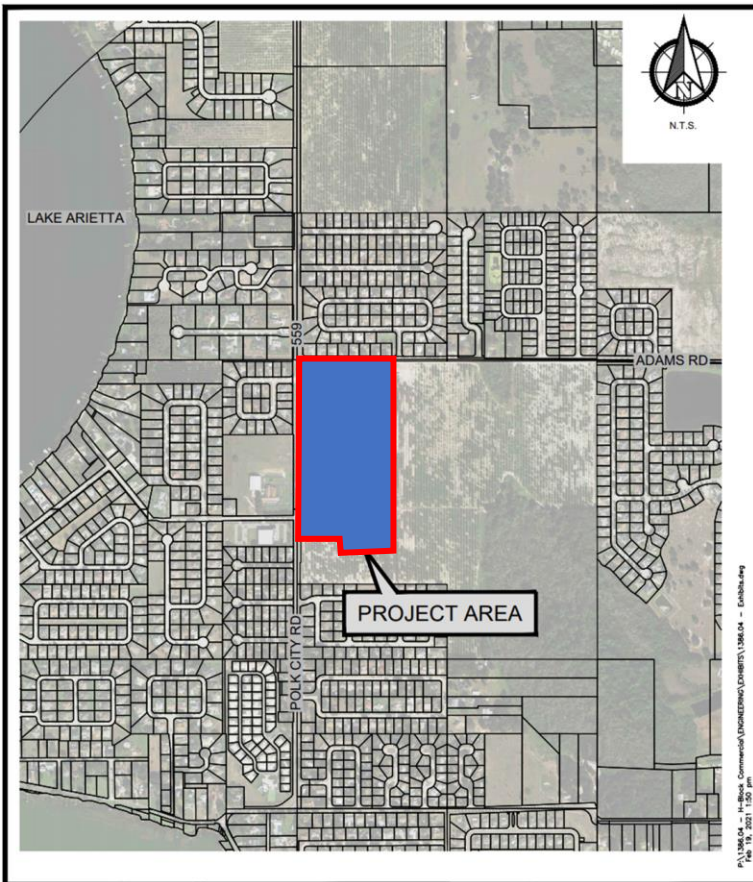
The proposed Land Development Regulations and Official Zoning Map Ordinance is entitled:  
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AUBURNDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 764, THE LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF AUBURNDALE, FLORIDA, BY RE-ESTABLISHING AN EXPIRED CITY OF AUBURNDALE ZONING MAP CLASSIFICATION OF PLANNED DEVELOPMENT-COMMERCIAL 1 (PD-C1) ON +/- 28.65 ACRES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (General Location: Hwy 559 and Adams Road).

**Amend the Zoning Map as follows:**

**H-Block Commercial Property:** Re-establish a City of Auburndale Zoning Classification of Planned Development-Commercial 1 on 28.65 acres.

Area: +/- 28.65 acres



The proposed Ordinance is available for review in the Planner's Office, City Hall, One Bobby Green Plaza, Florida, weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Interested parties may examine the Ordinance and Map there or appear at the meeting and be heard with respect to such proposed amendments.

At said hearing any person, his Agent or Attorney, may appear and be heard.
