MAJOR FUNCTIONS: This is responsible technical work involving the daily operation and maintenance of the City of Auburndale Water Treatment Facilities. Work is performed under the supervision of the Utility Plant Superintendent.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES: The successful applicant will be responsible for the operation, maintenance, and reporting at the water treatment facilities. The successful applicant will be responsible for sampling and analyzing the water treatment process to ensure plants are operating within appropriate parameters and are within state and federal guidelines. The water treatment facility operates 24/7 including holidays; this position requires the applicant to be able to work all shifts/schedules as assigned including 24 hours on call availability. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with City employees and the Public is essential. Performs other duties as assigned.

KNOWLEDGE, EDUCATION, AND EXPERIENCE: Knowledge of water treatment facility operation and maintenance techniques, landscaping equipment operation and occupational hazards. Ability to understand and follow verbal and written instructions. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with other employees is essential.

Graduation from High School or GED and one (1) year experience in water treatment plant operations and maintenance is required. Applicants must have a valid Class "C" Water Plant Operator's License. Must have a valid Florida Commercial Driver's License (Class B) or must obtain within 90 days.
