PARENTAL AGREEMENT

PAYMENT PROCEDURES

• **50%** of payment is due up front for all chosen sessions at the time of registration.

Failure to pay the balance by June 9th will result in the loss of any unpaid weeks.

REFUNDS

<u>Refunds will be granted through Friday, June 9th. No refunds will be issued after Friday, June 9th.</u>

DROP OFF AND PICK UP OF CHILDREN

- Participants will be allowed to leave camp only with the child's parent/guardian or a designated person by the parent/guardian (*this person must be designated in writing by the parent/guardian on the registration form*). If a child bikes or walks to camp, the parent/guardian must include on the registration form the time the child is permitted to leave camp.
- If someone is picking up the child other than the parent/guardian or designated person, the parent/guardian must inform the camp director of this change in writing prior to pick-up time.
- Camp hours are from 7:30am to 5:30pm. All campers should be picked up by 5:30pm. A late fee of \$10.00 for every 15 minutes per child will be assessed for any children picked up after 5:30pm. (*i.e., 1-15 mins=\$10;15-30 mins=\$20 etc.*)

DRESS CODE

- Campers should wear shorts of <u>APPROPRIATE LENGTH</u>, t-shirts with <u>APPROPRIATE LOGO</u> (no profanity, obscene imagery etc), sneakers and socks to camp. Flip flops, sandals or open-toed shoes are not permitted.
- Heeley's (shoes with wheels) are not allowed.
- Please mark all clothing and extra items with the child's first and last name.

FIELD TRIPS

- All campers and staff will attend each trip.
- A list of field trips will be finalized prior to the start of camp. Field trips are subject to change. However, every effort will be made to
 adhere to the field trips as listed. Parents/guardians will be notified of any changes.
- Campers must wear a camp t-shirt on all field trips. One t-shirt per camper will be provided. (Additional camp t-shirts may be purchased for \$10+tx.)

MEDICATION

• No medication can be administered by staff, as we do not have a nurse on duty.

LUNCHES AND SNACKS

- Lunch is provided. Afternoon snacks will be provided on a daily basis by the City of Auburndale. Children may bring their own lunch or snack, but please only send items that <u>do not need refrigeration</u>.
- An occasional field trip will require children to bring their own lunch. Parents will be notified in advance.

DISCIPLINE

- BULLYING WILL NOT BE TOLERATED IN ANY CAPACITY (i.e., verbal, physical, etc.)
- Campers will face consequences when camp rules are broken and/or when a child is uncooperative. For minor infractions such as
 these, the camp counselor will fill out a disciplinary action form. The parent will be informed by the camp director of any action
 taken.
- For major infractions, such as becoming violent to other campers or staff, the child's parent/guardian will be notified to pick up the child <u>immediately</u> from camp.
- CELL PHONES are prohibited. If your child has an emergency, he/she should go directly to the Site Director. This person will make any necessary phone calls.
- ELECTRONIC DEVICES such as tablets, video game consoles, etc. should <u>NOT</u> be brought to camp. The City of Auburndale and our staff cannot be responsible for these items.
- <u>No</u> money should be brought to camp unless instructed to do so. All activities are paid for through camp registration; camp staff will not be held responsible.
- Any recurring infractions of camp rules by a camper may result in suspension or dismissal from the day camp program.

HEAD LICE

 Camp brings children into close contact with one another daily. Therefore, camp can become a common site for the transmission of head lice from person-to-person. Any campers found to have lice and/or nits will be removed from camp. Campers will be readmitted after the designated staff person has inspected the child's head to determine that the camper has no lice/nits and/or when a note has been provided by a physician stating that the child is treated and free from lice/nits.
